Your AMERICAN RED CROSS – always ready to RESPOND

- ✓ Maintained 24 hour, 365 days-per-year communications network for use in time of military or disaster emergencies.
- ✓ Provided 34 services to local military families during an emergency such as death, serious illness, birth, or family incidents such as financial crisis or breakdown in childcare.
- ✓ Responded to 23 disaster incidents, including single- and multi-family fires, wind storm events and building collapses; providing 25 families with shelter, food, medicine, clothing and other essentials to assist in their recovery.
- ✓ Maintained a response team of 94 trained disaster volunteers.
- ✓ Continued delivering disaster services utilizing a 25-member Disaster Action Team.
- ✓ Collected 2,058 units of blood at the chapter's weekly Monday blood drives and 3,759 units across the chapter's jurisdiction.
- ✓ Offered the platelet donation (pheresis) program at the chapter—1st Thursday and 4th Saturday of each month collecting 381 platelet products for patient use during chemotherapy.

Your AMERICAN RED CROSS – always planning for a better PREPARED community

- ✓ Provided disaster preparedness information to 419 individuals - including coloring books for elementary children, pamphlets at events, and presentations on family disaster plans and kits.
- ✓ Taught "Be Red Cross Ready" disaster awareness program to 1,361 children and their parents.
- ✓ Planned, organized, collaborated, and initiated preparedness activities across an area with a total population of 58,103 enabling a timely and collaborative response in time of disaster.
- ✓ Provided "Get to Know Us" outreach material regarding the services of the Red Cross during deployment to 30 military members and their families.
- ✓ Issued 1,320 certificates in First Aid, CPR, and AED (Automatic External Defibrillator) use to individuals in businesses, schools and the community at large.
- ✓ Issued 349 certificates in water safety courses youth learn to swim classes and lifeguard training.
- ✓ Trained 47 lifeguards to work in area municipal pools and the Grand Bear Lodge in Utica.
- ✓ Maintained a staff of 62 instructors for health and safety courses (includes Authorized Providers of Red Cross programs).
- ✓ Trained 7 young adults in Babysitter's Training at the Illinois Valley Chapter.

YOUR RED CROSS – meeting other IDENTIFIED NEEDS in our community

- ✓ Referred over 2,500 individuals when Red Cross was not the correct agency to serve them.
- ✓ Delivered 40,192 meals to elderly and shut-ins in LaSalle and Peru in partnership with IVCH.
- ✓ Provided 470 screenings to area residents for high blood pressure and blood glucose.
